In doing so the Older Learner will become acquainted with and will use information communication technology to place stories on the Storyboard web page and have the opportunity to comment on these and interact with the authors using e-mail and messaging.

### Aims

The overall aim is to promote interaction between European Older Citizens by encouraging them to promote and exchange their Cultural Heritage using the new technologies.

### Objectives

- To promote, share and enrich the Cultural Heritage of all participants
- To become acquainted with the new technologies
- To allow participants the opportunity to learn another language
- To promote a sense of European belonging
- To counteract marginalisation, xenophobia and promote friendships
- To compile a collection of stories and experiences for intergenerational use
